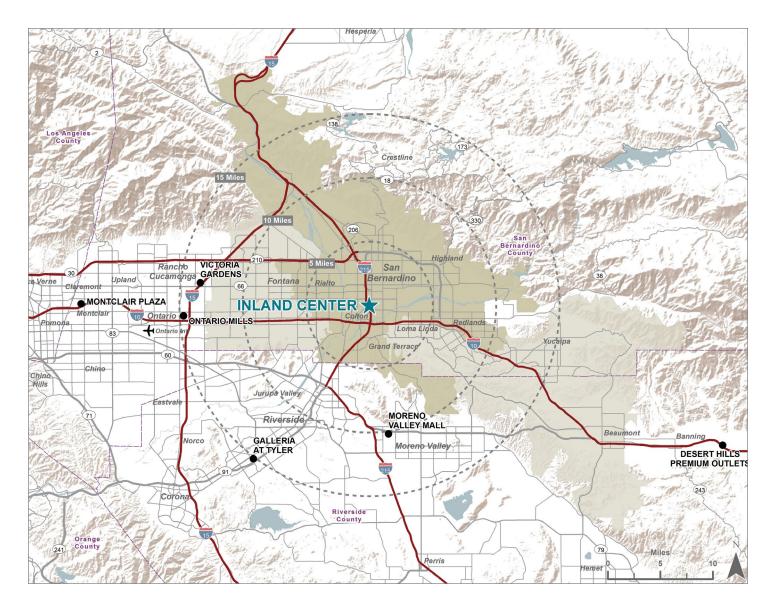

## TRADE AREA MAP



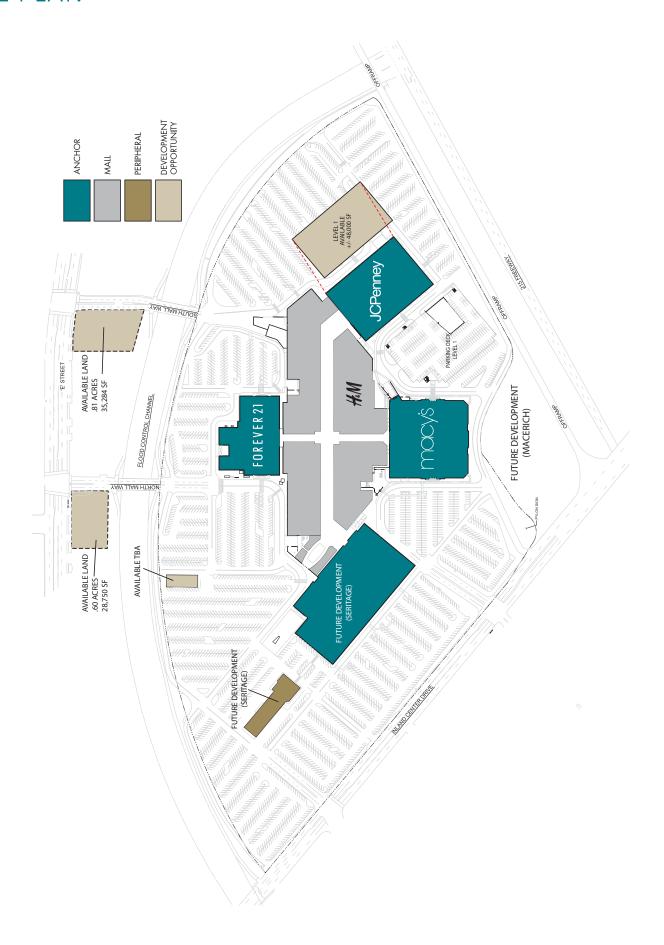
