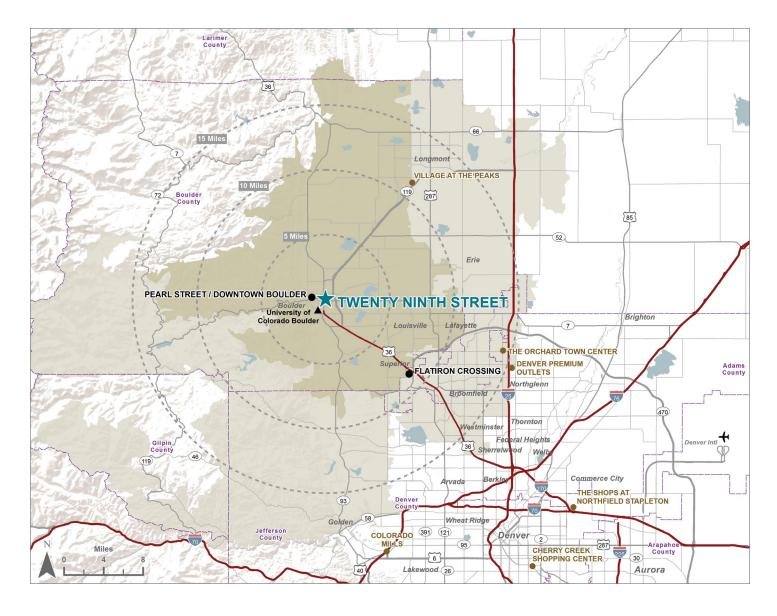

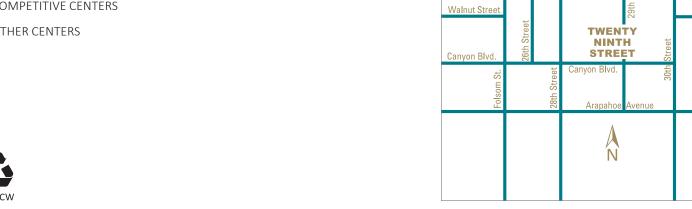

TRADE AREA MAP



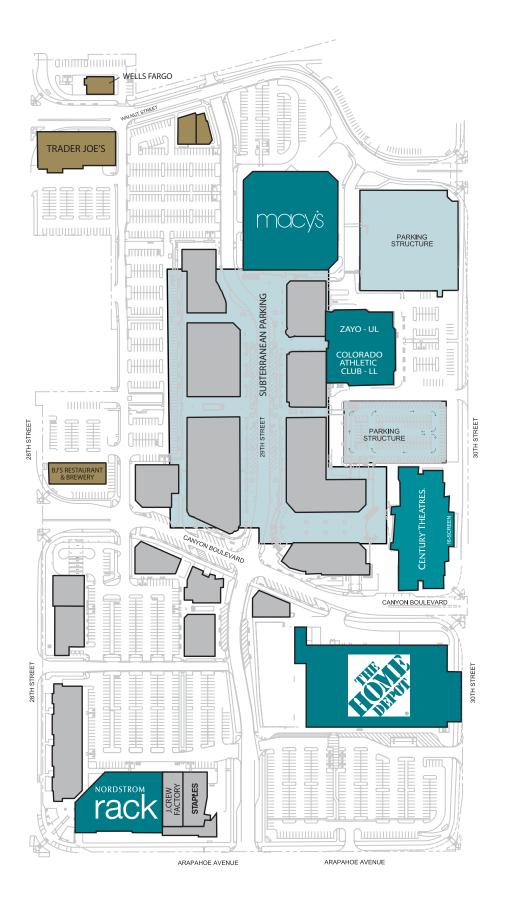

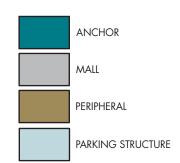

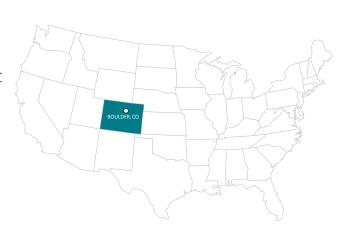
